A huge thank you to everyone who has volunteered to give their time to do Shark Watch.

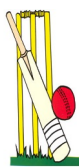


### KANGA CRICKET


